Attention Cyclone Scholars – 7th and 8th grade will be taking the Math MAP test today in your 6th hour class and you will remain there until the end of the day. Please bring a pencil and something to keep you busy after testing. Please also use the restroom quickly before testing so you are ready to test. Reminder that all 8th graders will be eating lunch right after your 5th hour class (E lunch) and then heading to 6th hour to test. It is very important that we get the testing started as soon as possible so everyone has enough time to complete the test. Do your very best so we can show the other middle schools that JMS really is the best middle school in Columbia. If you are an Algebra student you will not be testing today so you will head to the cafeteria at the beginning of 6th hour and will remain there until the end of the day.

On Monday 6th grade will begin testing and will be taking the English MAP test in your 2nd hour class and you will remain there until 12:05. It is very important that all students bring wired headphones (wireless headphones and smart watches are not allowed), a pencil and something to keep you busy after you have completed your tests. You will not be able to play on your phone or iPad until every person has finished testing. Be sure to get enough rest on Sunday night and eat breakfast on Monday morning.

On Monday 8th grade will also be taking the English MAP test. Please bring your wired headphones (wireless headphones and smart watches are not allowed) a pencil if you have one and something to keep you busy after testing.

Be sure to get enough rest on Sunday night and eat breakfast and lunch before you begin testing. 8th grade will continue to eat E lunch right after 5th hour through Tuesday of next week, while we are testing. Be sure to charge your iPads over the weekend so they are ready for testing.
