Parking Fee: \$50.00 for 1st Semester, \$25.00 for 2nd Semester (Begins). Please make checks payable to CPS or RBHS.

Any vehicle a student parks at RBHS/CACC must be registered. Please notify Safety & Security with vehicle changes.

Students of any grade may submit an application for parking. The application must be returned with the vehicle description, license plate number, copy of insurance policy information and copy of student's driver's license ID. A parent signature is required to process registration.

A properly completed application allows students to purchase a parking hand tag. The tag must be properly displayed, hanging from the rearview mirror with the individual tag number visible any time the vehicle is on school property. The tag is registered to one person and cannot be given to another student. The hang tag must not be altered in any way, or it will become void and must be replaced at cost to student.

Student parking is not allowed in faculty or visitor parking. Parking is not allowed in fire lanes, against red curbs, in driving lanes, on grassed areas, other non-parking areas, or ADA accessible parking spaces without the proper state permit.

Failure to register and/or properly display a valid parking hang tag may result in a RBHS warning sticker applied to the vehicle, a Columbia Municipal ticket, towing of vehicle at owner's expense, or additional disciplinary consequences.

Student parking is first come – first served basis. There are approximately 46 student spots in the South lot, 200 in the lot directly North of RBHS, and 350 spots East and North of the baseball field.

Parking is a privilege that may be revoked or suspended without refund. Excessive tardiness, absences, or disciplinary referrals may be grounds for revocation of parking. Students are not allowed to loiter in the parking lots and should exit and lock their vehicle upon arrival at school. Operating a vehicle in a reckless manner will result in revocation or suspension of parking privilege. 10 MPH is considered the safe maximum speed in the parking lots.

Vehicle accidents and other parking lot safety concerns are to be reported to the main office. RBHS is not responsible for vehicle damage that may occur in the parking lot. Students are responsible for damages that they cause.

Vehicles parked on school district property are subject to search by school officials who are justified by reasonable suspicion.
