Young readers have the opportunity to earn a free book by following these 3 easy steps:

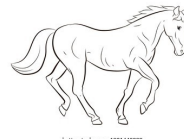
1. Read any 8 books this summer & record them in your Summer Reading Journal. Tell us which part of the book is your favorite, and why.

Summer 2022



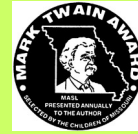
