

**Policy DH-2: BONDED EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS**

**Columbia Public Schools**

Status: ADOPTED

*(Urban Districts)*

The treasurer and secretary of the Columbia School District Board of Education shall enter into a bond to the state of Missouri, in accordance with law and Board policy, with one or more sureties approved by the Board. The bonds shall be filed with the secretary of the Board.

In addition to the treasurer and secretary, employees who perform the duties of the treasurer but have not been elected to the position will also enter into a surety bond. The Board may require other officers and employees to be bonded.


