Waiver for Policy IKF, Graduation Requirements

In accordance with Governor Parson's waiver of state statutes with regard to graduation requirements and the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education changing certain graduation expectations for students graduating in the spring of 2020, the Columbia Board of Education approves to waive the following graduation requirements for the Class of 2020, as defined in Policy IKF:

- Requirement 1 – The half credit of Personal Finance
- Requirement 2 – Examinations on the provisions and principles of American history, American institutions, American civics, and the Missouri and U.S. Constitutions (§§ 170.011, .345, RSMo.)
- Requirement 5 – Required EOC tests (DESE Graduation Guidance)
- Requirement 6 – CPR and Heimlich Procedure training (§ 170.310, RSMo.)
