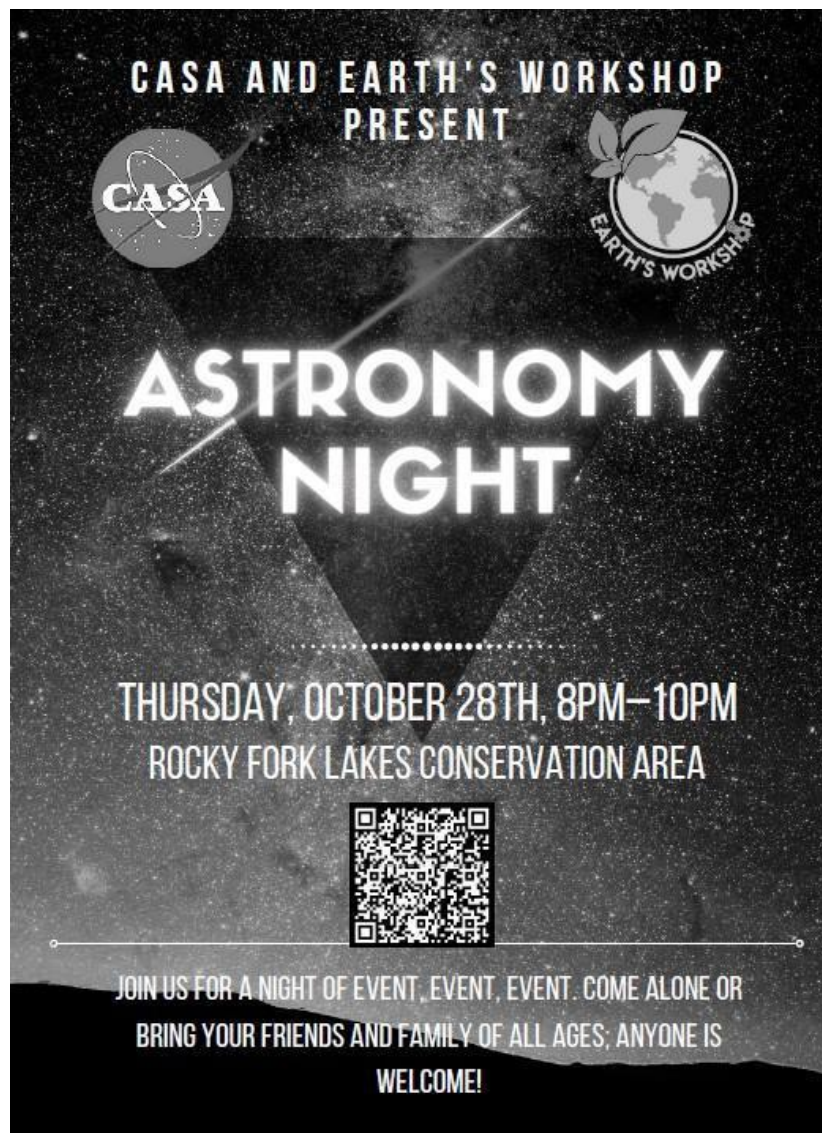

It is that time! AP Test Registration. There are three steps students must complete to be signed up for an AP Test in May:

- **Go into the AP Classroom you've set up and change it to say "Yes" for taking the test. Any students left as UNDECIDED after the deadline will be counted as NOs.**
- **Complete the Google Form: <https://forms.gle/s1aLL1fpeTH9i8ZEA>**
 - **Complete Payment either online or in person.**

Students who are on Free/Reduced Lunch can have fees waived. Their guardian must complete the process on the Family Portal that allows the district to disclose to me that they are eligible.
