COLUMBIA VALUES DIVERSITY CELEBRATION STUDENT WRITINGS PROGRAM

Each year, the City of Columbia's Columbia Values Diversity committee includes a student writings program as part of its annual celebration of diversity in our community. The program is available for students in grades 4-12.

This year the theme is: "*Healing Together.*"

Student writings should not be more than one page typed or two pages handwritten. An independent selection committee will choose selected writings from all grade levels for publication. The booklet will be distributed at the Columbia Values Diversity Celebration on Thursday, January 13, 2022, and published on the celebration website. Three or four students will be selected to read their works and be featured in a video produced by the City Channel, which will be played at the celebration as well as broadcast after the event.

Submission guidelines for the program are attached. These guidelines also include brief prompts designed to stimulate student thought and creativity. There is also an online submission option should students wish to submit independently.

The **submission deadline is Friday, November 19, 2021.** Entries can be sent to the Community Relations Office at the Aslin Administration Building. We look forward to sharing your students' creative literary work with others throughout our community.
