KEWPIES, we are experiencing a higher volume of theft in the building! Here are some basic steps to secure your valuables that will reduce, if not eliminate, these thefts.

- **AVOID BRINGING** valuable items to school!
- **If a student cannot lock valuables in their locker, then lock them in the glove box of your car. If not, keep them on your person. DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES IN AN UNATTENDED BACKPACK.**
- **Students, IF YOU SEE SOMETHING, REPORT IT, as soon as possible, to a trusted faculty member.**

- **Students, the FIRST LINE of defense with theft as with other crimes is to secure your property and SECOND, if you see or hear something, please say something!**

AP TEST REGISTRATION INFORMATION

It is that time! AP Test Registration. There are three steps students must complete to be signed up for an AP Test in May:

- **Go into the AP Classroom you've set up and change it to say "Yes" for taking the test. Any students left as UNDECIDED after the deadline will be counted as NOs.**
- **Complete the Google Form: <https://forms.gle/s1aLL1fpeTH9i8ZEA>**
- **Complete \$40 non-refundable deposit, per test, either online or in person (to Lisa Chalupny in West Office) by Friday, November 5.**
- **Deposit will not be refunded in the event you do not take the test!**
- **Students who are on Free/Reduced Lunch have fees waived. Their guardian must complete the process on the Family Portal that allows the district to disclose to me that they are eligible.**
- ***Signing up after November 5 may result in a \$40, per exam, late fee!***
- **All remaining fees are due by Friday, March 11. No money will be collected on test days.**

Parents & Guardians:

We are having a significant decrease in free and reduced-price eligible families in the district because all meals are free to scholars this year. However, this may affect additional household benefits if there is not an approved application on file. It also decreases the districts' ability to access additional resources for our scholars such as grants opportunities that allow the district to provide additional programs of interest to our scholars.

Each year, the City of Columbia's Columbia Values Diversity committee includes a student writings program as part of its annual celebration of diversity in our community. The program is available for students in grades 4-12.

Student writings should not be more than one page typed or two pages handwritten. An independent selection committee will choose selected writings from all grade levels for publication. Three or four students will be selected to read their works and be featured in a video produced by the City Channel, which will be played at the celebration as well as broadcast after the event.
