Saturday will mark the twentieth anniversary of the September 11th attacks. On that day:

- **8:46 a.m., five hijackers crashed American Airlines Flight 11 into the World Trade Center's North Tower.**
- **At 9:03 a.m., another five hijackers crashed United Airlines Flight 175 into the South Tower.**
- **At 9:37 AM, five hijackers flew American Airlines Flight 77 into the Pentagon.**
- **A fourth flight, United Airlines Flight 93, under the control of four hijackers, crashed near Shanksville, Pennsylvania, southeast of Pittsburgh, at 10:03 a.m. after the passengers fought the hijackers.**

Almost 3,000 American lives were lost on 9/11. Let's pay tribute to the innocent bystanders who fell victim to these senseless attacks, and the heroes who lost their lives in the process of saving others. A moment of silence was shared during the morning announcements!
