REVOLUTION PREP - We've partnered with Revolution Prep to bring test prep events to Hickman students.

One is for the ACT Boot Camp happening September 22. It is a two-hour online event where students will learn basic tips and tricks to do better on the ACT test. This is primarily designed for 11th and 12th graders but is open to anyone. Cost is \$15.

The second is for the PSAT Boot Camp happening October 6. Also, a two-hour online event, this is for the PSAT and is targeted for 10th and 11th graders. Cost is \$15.

Finally, the third flier is for practice tests in both the PSAT and the ACT. Students will also take this online and get a score back quickly. Taking a practice test opens an opportunity for free 30-minute individual consultation on subject areas needing work. The cost for each practice exam is \$10.

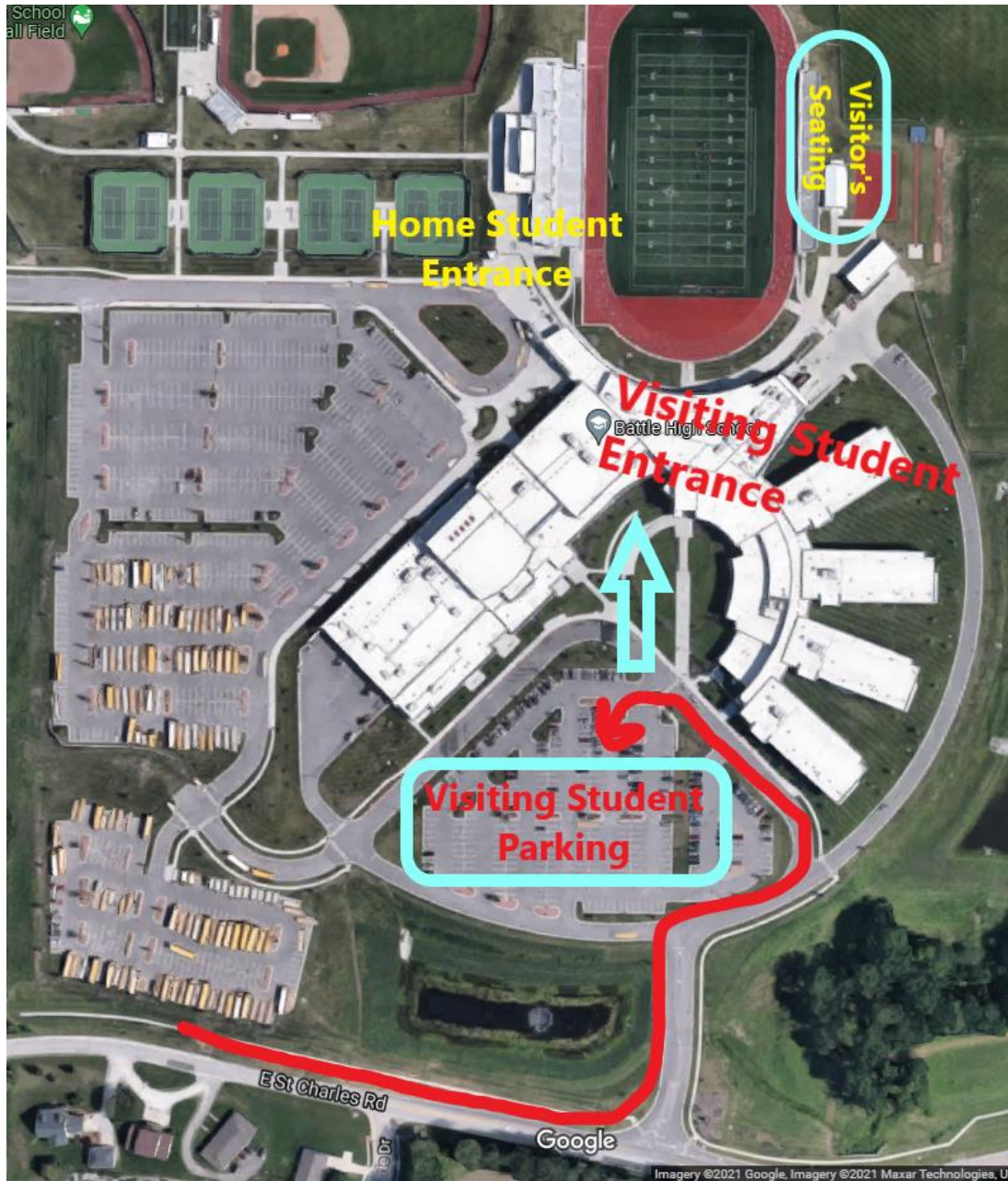
