Seniors: On October 5 you are scheduled to take the ACT during the school day. Only those students who did not request a district voucher for spring testing are eligible. Please check your student email for more information.

SENIOR ACT - The district is offering the senior ACT October 5 for all students who **DID NOT request a district voucher last spring.**

- **During the next two weeks students will complete necessary pre-administration through English classes.**
- **On test day, seniors should report to school by 8:55 even if they have part time on their schedule for morning B day blocks.**
- **Seniors should plan on bringing number 2 pencils, a calculator, and their student ID or driver's license.**
- **Testing will be finished in the early afternoon followed by lunch and 4th block.**

Seniors who requested a district *voucher will NOT* be testing on October 5. A study hall will be offered on that day. Families who choose to have their students participate in college visits or other off-campus activities that day should contact the attendance office to excuse their senior.

- 1. No money is due on picture day!**
- 2. 3-5 days after picture day, proofs will be emailed and/or texted to you via the data on file with the school for your student.**
- 3. DRESS CODE: 2 outfits will be photographed with a variety of poses in each. The school's dress code for the yearbook is: YOUR CHOICE OF TUX, DRAPE, OR STUDENT'S CHOICE OF DRESS CLOTHING! Tuxes and drapes will be provided. Caps & gowns will also be provided. What to wear:**
 - Guys: If you choose to be photographed in a tux shirt, bow-tie, and jacket provided by Wagner, please wear a solid white t-shirt to wear underneath the tux shirt.**
 - Girls: If you choose to be photographed in a traditional drape, we suggest wearing a tank-top that has thin straps that can easily be pulled down when putting on the drape.**
 - All: A free senior cap and gown session will also be photographed. Wagner will provide the caps and gowns.**
