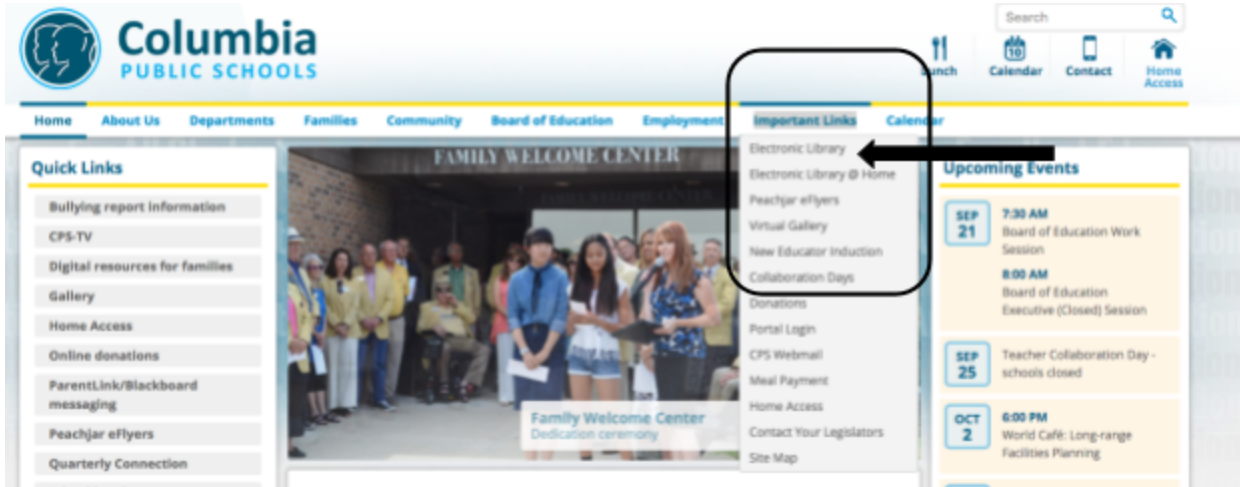
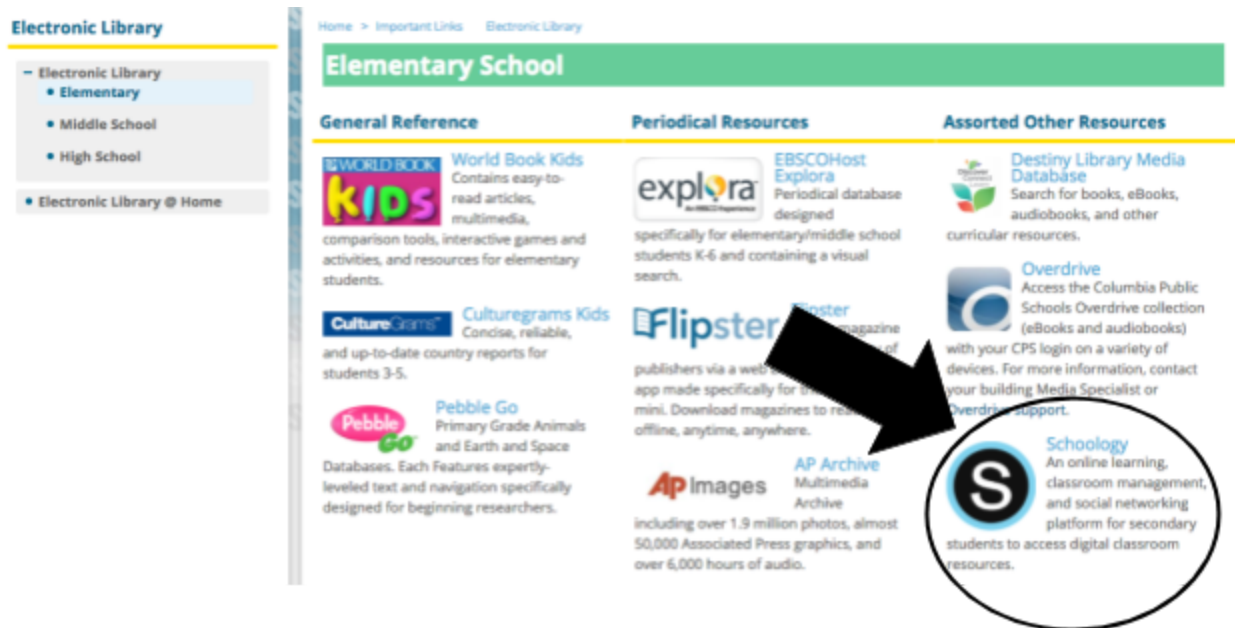


## HOW TO ACCESS THE EVERYDAY MATH MATERIALS FROM HOME!
