We want to share with you a few reminders and updates.

School Meals

Our meal delivery process went smoothly this first day! We'd like to provide some additional updates to the process:

- Students ages 2-18 can obtain a meal for free. Adults may pick up meals for students who are unable to do so. A student number is not required for each student meal set that is obtained. If a child is not enrolled at CPS, we will need to know the child's name, and parent/guardian name and contact information. - In addition to those stops, the following four school buildings will have nutrition services staff available **between the hours of 9:30 and 11:00 every morning** if families would prefer to stop by the building to pick up food
