HICKMAN HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT RULES FOR 2021-2022

- **PARKING HANG TAGS WILL BE ASSIGNED** during the summer of 2021. **STUDENTS MAY PARK IN ANY OF THE LOTS WITH YELLOW LINES. PARKING IN THE LOTS WITH WHITE LINES WILL RESULT IN A WARNING ATICKET OR THE CAR BEING TOWED!**
- **A WAITING LIST WILL BE MAINTAINED** if all parking hang tags are assigned.
- **YOUR PARKING HANG TAG MUST BE HANGING IN THE SAME VEHICLE** indicated on your application on file in the main office. If you need to drive another car move the parking tag to that car and inform the parking attendant.
- **LARGE GREEN STICKERS** will be placed on all cars who are in violation of the parking rules – parking without a parking tag, parking in handicapped spots, parking in spots not used for parking, parking in a white lined lot, etc. Two stickers or tickets may result in your **CAR being TOWED, your hang tag being revoked, and parking privilege taken away the following year.**
- **PLEASE REPORT VEHICLES PARKED WITHOUT A PARKING HANG TAG TO THE PARKING LOT ATTENDANT OR THE WEST OFFICE.**
- **IF YOU LOSE OR MISPLACE YOUR PARKING TAG, more than once, the REPLACEMENT TAGS** will cost \$25.
- **IF YOU NO LONGER WISH TO USE YOUR PARKING TAG** you must inform the Main Office and your tag will go to the next person on the waiting list.
- **YOU CANNOT TRANSFER OR SELL YOUR TAG TO ANOTHER STUDENT.**
- **CITY PARKING TICKETS WILL COST A MINIMUM OF \$15.** City tickets will be given for parking in handicapped spots, non-parking areas, and parking in fire lanes (red or yellow curbs).
- **LOSS OF PARKING PRIVILEGE:** Students who violate Hickman High School policies regarding parking will face disciplinary consequences, fines, or towing.
- **PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR PARKING PRIVILEGE MAY BE REVOKED** (without refund) for the remainder of the school year in the following situations:
 - ANY SUSPENSION related to drug and alcohol use, possession, or sale**
 - Continued loud music on the lot Third suspension **FOR ANY REASON**
 - Failure to display hangtag on mirror Multiple disciplinary infractions
 - Dangerous driving of **ANY KIND** on lot Three or more parking stickers
 - Failure to adhere to **ANY** parking lot rule(s) listed on this page
- **HICKMAN HIGH SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY** damage incurred on the parking lot. You are responsible for any damage you cause to another vehicle on the parking lot.
