These opportunities support a positive school culture which allows us to recruit and retain effective teachers.

#### Describe activities

Each spring there are numerous events where preschool parents are given opportunities to learn more about the elementary school at the preschool site. Also, there are transition meetings with preschool and the home schools to make sure critical information about the student is passed on to the new school. In addition, families have an opportunity to meet the kindergarten teachers and tour the school during kindergarten registration.

Preschool teachers for the most at risk students are at the home elementary on the first day of school to help with the transition and to assist with parent questions since relationships are stronger with the preschool teacher than the new elementary school
